

A4 Transport provides fully compliant, secure road haulage for hazardous materials and dangerous goods under strict ADR (European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road) regulations.

Certified & Qualified Personnel

- **ADR-Certified Drivers:** Drivers trained and certified to handle packaged and bulk hazardous goods across various classes, ensuring strict adherence to safety protocols during loading, transport, and discharge.
- **DGSA Oversight:** Guidance from a Dangerous Goods Safety Adviser (DGSA) to ensure proper classification, operational compliance, and legal safety standards are continuously met.

Vehicle Compliance & Safety Equipment

- **Fully Equipped Vehicles:** Fleet equipped with required ADR safety kit items, including fire extinguishers, personal protective equipment (PPE), hazard warning placards, and spill containment equipment.
- **Specialised Transport Options:** Capability to handle various ADR classes—such as Class 2 (Gases), Class 3 (Flammable Liquids), Class 8 (Corrosives), and Class 9 (Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods)—in full loads, partial loads, or compliant small-load quantities (LQ exemptions).
